

Keith Leaphart, DO, MBA

In 2013, Dr. Leaphart was appointed Chair of the Board of Directors for The Lenfest Foundation, where he oversaw the distribution of over \$300M to Philadelphia-based nonprofit organizations over ten years and played a crucial role in helping disadvantaged youth in Philadelphia through early learning, out-of-school care, and career planning initiatives. In 2018, Dr. Leaphart launched Philanthropi®, an innovative digital and social engagement platform that aims to transform charitable giving by highlighting "everyday gifts of time, talent and treasure" and amplifying awareness and excitement for lifelong philanthropy. As a business consultant, he has also worked with local health systems and corporations as an advisor to improve workplace diversity initiatives. In addition to his philanthropic and entrepreneurial pursuits, Dr. Leaphart maintains an active medical license and served as relief staff physician at the Bryn Mawr Rehabilitation Hospital for 16 years. He completed his residency in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital from 2004-2007, while simultaneously achieving his MBA from St. Joseph's University. Dr. Leaphart holds positions on various prominent boards, including the Lenfest Institute for Journalism, Philadelphia Health Management Corporation, and the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.
